Dear Sirs:

Ever since the TMI nuclear accident (something you said would never happen) on March 28 it has been a wet season. We farmers could not plow or work our grounds to plant oats & corn. It has been raining almost every day or every other day. I planted my oats on the 7th of May the latest I ever planted in all my farming of 40 years. I only have 5 acres of corn planted and still have some plowing to do. The winter springs never stopped as they usually do in April. All farmers here have the same trouble. The hay season is here and already a lot of farmers lost a lot of hay due to the rains.

I've heard before that the nuclear industry has the clouds seeded to make rain so that the rivers provide plenty of water for the "nukes". It seems you and the industry have no regard for us farmers here and that it gives you something to laugh about and think it's a joke. I know you have some "hot nukes" on your hands especially Mead's TMI hot one. I can say that that is just too bad. But if the clouds are seeded to make those rains, you're just going to have to stop that monkey business. You're all grown men and supposed to be educated to know better.

During all of the TMI fiasco you and the industry ever talked of the X-rays type of radiation that emits from nuclear reactors and goes in all directions for many miles and injured all vegetation and animal life and people and even kills them with cancers, leukemia, enema

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infections like was found on Clair Hoover's cattle and many others. Tax paid officials were brave enough to discredit these truths but hide behind arguments of malnutrition, mismanagement, inbreds, filth and even the lamest of all excuses that the radiation in the walls, which were since George Washington's time, killed the cattle.
