Dear Mr. Lewis:

This is in response to your request that we reschedule the scoping meeting for the programmatic environmental impact statement on the decontamination and disposal of radioactive wastes resulting from the accident at TMI-2. The meeting is scheduled for January 29, 1980, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

At this late date, our meeting cannot be rescheduled. There is not enough time to notify the more than 200 people who are expected to attend the meeting. Also, yours is the only request we have received to change it.

Your written comments on the scope of the statement and the issues which should be considered in depth are welcome and should be received in my office by February 15, 1980.
