I am writing in response to your letter to Mr. Manning Muntzing regarding the accident at Three Mile Island. Mr. Muntzing no longer works for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, so I will respond to your request for information. I regret that this answer to your letter has been delayed. The accident and its consequences have created a substantial increase in the agency's workload, which has prevented us from responding to you as promptly as we would have liked.


The accident was not a hoax. I am enclosing summaries of two reports recently issued regarding an investigation of the accident's causes and the health effects of the accident.
