In reference to your letter FCTC:JEJ 71-9006, ⁷¹⁻⁹⁰⁰⁷~~71-9006~~, 71-6679 dated 4 February 1980, the USS SHENANDOAH (AD-26) has a request pending to terminate their Nuclear Regulatory Commission license for possession and use of radioactive material. Consequently registration as a user will not be required in the future.

It is recommended that all correspondence to ships be addressed to the attention of the Commanding Officer vice the name of any particular person. This will prevent distribution errors occasioned by military personnel transfer.

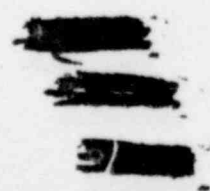
