
MOTION OF JOHN O'NEILL II, INTERVENER, FOR PLEADING OUT OF TIME

This motion is contingent upon my MOTION FOR PLEADING OUT OF TIME being denied, and I drop today's motion should the former have been accepted.

James Olson, the attorney assisting me in preparing my brief on the advisability of examining the need for power issues in this spent fuel pool expansion hearing, mistakenly believed that the deadline for filing was extended by the Board to March 15, and consequently prepared nothing by the actual deadline of Monday, March 3, 1980. This, coupled with my very heavy work schedule at a new job, and a visit by my parents, prevented me from filing on time. I discussed a postponement of the deadline until March 10, 1980 with NRC Counsel, Janice Moore, Consumers Power Counsel Joseph Gallo, and Christa-Mariis Attorney, Ellen Weisay, and no one objected to the delay. I informed Mr. Herbert Grossman of this on the afternoon of March 3, and he indicated that he would very likely grant an extension.
