REBUTTAL TO MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM COPY REQUIREMENT

John O'Neill II moves that I be relieved of the burden of sending 20 copies of my motion for relief from copy requirement by 10 CFR 2.708(f)(1) pursuant to the motion instead to serve single copies on all of the parties, including the NRC, retaining the memory of one licensing copy, and two copies on the NRC Chairman and the Commission.

Relief from the 20 copy requirement is essential to allow me to devote all of my severely limited resources to substantive participation in this proceeding. An unnecessary drain on my resources will severely limit my ability to participate effectively and to assist the Licensing Board in reaching its decision.

Paper, stencils and postage are a burden to a man who has an outstanding gas bill and phone bill, (much of the phone charges were indeed incurred in this licensing matter.)

The precedent for this motion is the relief granted all Intervenors in Metropolitan Edison Co., (Three Mile Island Unit Number 1), Docket Number 50-289 (Restart), and the relief granted by this board to Christa-Maria, Jim Miller and John Biers from this same 20 copy requirement, ORDER GRANTING CHRISTA-MARIA RELIEF FROM THE 20 COPY REQUIREMENT OF 10 CFR 2.708(f)(1), dated February 25, 1980.

As there were no objections offered to Christa-Maria's motion of February 1, 1980, no objections are anticipated. And since I am confident that the board will also grant this motion, I am being so bold as to mail copies to all on the service list and two copies to the Secretary of the Commission only. Since this has essentially been my practice in the past, and this particular practice has caused no objections, I do not anticipate difficulties. Should the board deny my motion, however, I shall immediately forward to the NRC the additional copies.
