Per our conversation today I am writing this to advise you of our present security program at our West Chicago facility.

- 1. Gloss Guard and Investigation Service, Inc. provides 24-hours per day, seven days per week coverage of the facility. A copy of the Guard Procedures is enclosed for your information. This procedure will be revised as required in the future.
 - Regular outside perimeter inspections are being conducted to maintain fences, signs, and closures of doors and windows.
 - 3. A cable barrier has been installed across the North end of the driveway to stop unauthorized vehicular traffic between the railroad and the West side of the factory from Ann Street to the disposal site.
 - Kerr-McGee's Director of Corporate Security will be making periodic inspections and reviews of the facility to aid onsite personnel.
 - Identification cards, with pictures, will be used for regular employees and contractors identification.
 - Theft target items are being secured (out of sight) in the plant.
