I read with dismay on the front page of the L.A. Times (1st week in April) that the 3-Mile Island nuclear power plant in Harrisburg, PA was ALLOWED BY THE NRC to open on Dec. 30, 1978 so that Met. Edison could save 5 MILLION DOLLARS by income tax data shuffling. This ALLOWANCE BY THE NRC, was despite numerous plant malfunctions during November and December.

As a resident of San Luis Obispo County (where the NRC is at present guardian of public safety as regards the licensing of Diablo Canyon) I am outraged by the L.A. Times Report. Also as Community Relations Coordinator for the Environmental Center of San Luis Obispo County, I formally request any and all public access to information about the NRC's decision to license "3-mile" on 12.30.78.
