Gentlemen:

In accordance with your application dated May 18, 1979, as supplemented February 5, 1980, and pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 70, Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-777 is hereby amended to include your decommissioning plan and financial commitment. Accordingly, Condition No. 21 is replaced with the following:

Condition 21. At the end of plant life, the licensee shall decontaminate the facilities and site in accordance with the general decommissioning plan submitted in the enclosure to the letter dated May 18, 1979, so that these facilities and grounds can be released to unrestricted use. The financial commitment from UNC Resources, Inc., to assure that funds will be available for decommissioning, given in the letter dated February 5, 1980, is hereby incorporated as a condition of the license.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.
