SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR LIMITED SUBPOENA AUTHORITY

As directed by the Commission, IE, with OIA assistance, is continuing its investigation at Three Mile Island. We estimate that we will need to interview thirty to forty licensee employees during this investigation. On April 10, 1980, NRC investigators interviewed seven of the TMI operating staff. Others, thereafter, refused to be interviewed unless they were subpoenaed. Testimony from these individuals is essential to our investigation. Accordingly, I request that the Commission delegate to me the authority to issue the necessary subpoenas in this matter. I do not request authority for redelegation. I will personally evaluate the necessity for each subpoena issued. The authority is requested to be in effect only until June 10, 1980. The proposed delegation prepared by OELD is attached.
