19 CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: Which is, this is the dissent from
20 the jurisdictional reach of the order.

21 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Well do you agree with this
22 order or do you not agree with this?

23 CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: I agree with the order which
24 indicates that I am dissenting.

25 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: I just want to be sure.

1 COMMISSIONER HENDRIE: Why don't you call for the "ayes"?

2 CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: All in favor of this order?

3 (Chorus of ayes.)

4 CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: And I agree that this order
5 accurately reflects my position.

6 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: You are not voting against
7 the order.

8 CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: I am dissenting from the Commission's
9 jurisdictional determinations.

10 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: What is the vote on this order?

11 MR. CHILK: The vote on the order is 2 to 1.

12 CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: 2 to 1.

13 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Okay.

14 MR. CHILK: Yourself and Dr. Hendrie constituting
15 a majority and the Chairman dissenting.

16 COMMISSIONER HENDRIE: By god, Vick, we have carried
17 the day.

18 CHAIRMAN AHEARNE: And we will let appropriate
19 individuals know of the results, I assume.
