Dear Mr. Felton:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, I request the following documents, records, or portions thereof, as described herein;

containing any and all toll-free telephone numbers by which any component of the NRC can be contacted;

containing a concise description of the nuclear fuel cycle as it occurs in the United States;

containing a concise description of the lawful responsibility of each of the various governmental components which regulate any part of the nuclear fuel cycle and/or regulate any activities involving trans-uranic materials and/or radiation and/or radiation protection of humans. (I suspect the NRC has such a document as a means of being aware of governmental components with related, similiar, and even overlapping responsibilities.)

- containing name, title, and exact location of the NRC employees having chief responsibility for the following NRC activities -
 - a. testing and evaluating reliability and effectiveness of nuclear reactor emergency core cooling systems.
 - b. identifying nuclear reactors located on or near known or suspected earthquake zones, volcanos, or geologic faults.
 - c. determining the adequacy of population evacuation plans established by NRC nuclear reactor operation licensees, designed to be implemented when deemed necessary in event of a nuclear emergency.
 - d. determination of violations of NRC rules and/or regulations by any person, persons, or other entity - and determination and recording of what penalties or sanctions, if any, were imposed, against the violators.
 - e. liason with the U.S. Department of Agriculture.
 - f. enforcement of radiation and radioactivity environmental release standards.
 - g. evaluating the adequacy and efficacy of enforcement activities regarding radiation and radioactivity environmental release standards.
 - h. determining the proximity to human populations the NRC permits for nuclear power plants, in respect to human health and safety.

Also, I request a document(s) or portion(s) thereof, which concisely describe the powers and responsibilities of the commissioners and chairman of the NRC, their names, titles, exact governmental locations, duration and tenure of office, mechanism by which attained office, mechanisms by which each may be removed from office and/or otherwise subject to disciplinary action - and upon what basis can it be done?
