The Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A, as revised through Amendment No.18, are hereby incorporated in the license. The licensee shall operate the facility in accordance with the Technical Specifications.





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- (a) The Operations & Maintenance Superintendent need not hold an SOL provided he meets the other requirements of 6.3.1 of these specifications and the position of "Operations Supervisor" is filled. Under these conditions, the Operations Supervisor shall be responsible for directing the activities of licensed operators.
- (b) This position need not be filled if the Operations & Maintenance Superintendent holds an SOL.

"Responsible for overall implementation of the plant Fire Protection Program.

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6.4 TRAINING

- 6.4.1 A retraining and replacement training program for the plant staff shall be maintained under the direction of the Plant Superintendent and shall meet or exceed the requirements and recommendations of Section 5.5 of ANSI N18.1-1971 and Appendix "A" of 10 CFR, Part 55.
- 6.4.2 A training program for the Fire Brigade shall be maintained under the direction of the Plant Training Coordinator and shall meet or exceed the requirements of Section 27 of the NFPA Code-1975 except for Fire Brigade training sessions which shall be held at least quarterly.

6.5 REVIEW AND AUDIT

6.5.1 PLANT REVIEW COMMITTEE (PRC)

6.5.1.1 The Plant Review Committee (PRC) shall function to advise the Plant Superintendent on all matters related to nuclear safety.

6.5.1.2 COMPOSITION

The PRC shall be composed of the:

6.5.1.3 ALTERNATES
