This is in response to your letter of May 6, 1980, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 10 categories of documents relating to the proposed decontamination of Dresden I.

In response to your request, copies of the documents listed in Appendix A are enclosed. Copies of these documents are also being placed in the NRC Public Documents Room (PDR), located at 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC.

Also in response to your request, we wish to inform you that in two previous FOIA requests identified as FOIA-79-544 (McCULLOUGH) and FOIA-78-217 (HANSELL), copies of NRC documents relating to the subject of your inquiry were placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), located at 1717 H Street, Washington, DC 20555, where they are available for public inspection and copying. The charge for reproducing records located in the PDR is eight cents (\$0.08) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a) of the Commission's regulations, a copy of which is enclosed. Upon your direct request to the PDR and your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Potomac Research, Inc., a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed directly by Potomac Research, Inc., for the reproduction charges plus tax and postage.

Copies of the FOIA-79-544 and FOIA-78-217 requests and our responses thereto are enclosed for your use.
