Tear Mr. MacDonald:

Recently we received your form letters requesting the submission of consolidated safety analyses along with the subject applications for renewal.

Based upon previous conversations with your staff, we understood that submission of such consolidated analyses would not be required for this renewal because the packages have specific uses and are seldom used by GAC and the few others involved in our material shipments. Accordingly, we had submitted on January 31, 1980 our renewal applications, reference (a) and reference (b), and fees for the administrative renewal of the package Certificates of Compliance.

This confirms our telephone conversation's acceptance of revised expiration dates of May 31, 1981 rather than May 31, 1985 for COC-9072 and June 30, 1981 rather than June 30, 1985 for COC-5938, and reconfirms our intent to submit a consolidated safety analysis as part of the 1981 renewal applications.

We look forward to your renewal of the subject Certificates of Compliance with expiration dates of May 31, 1981 and June 30, 1981, respectively.
