Pursuant to your letter of December 14, 1979 and telephone conversations during January and March between our offices, the scope of Colorado's technical assistance request regarding the Pioneer Uravan, Inc., uranium mill near Slick Rock, Colorado, is confirmed as follows:

- NRC's proposed schedule and subject outline, provided in your December 14, 1979 letter, is responsive to the Department's request of october 3, 1979, and is acceptable.
- As discussed with Ms. Hamill in January, the Department request includes environmental consequences of plant and transportation accidents, but not routine mill radiation protection;
- 3. Because transfer of the site to federal control is to occur, evaluation of both solid and liquid waste confinement structures for conformance to NRC regulatory guidance, particularly Regulatory Guides 3.11 and 3.11.1, is requested as a part of or supplement to NRC's Environmental Assessment.
