This refers to the inspection conducted by Ms. M. Campbell and Mr. F. Costello of this office on April 16, 1980 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 06-01781-08, 06-01781-03 and SNM-205 and to the discussions of our findings held by Ms. Campbell and Mr. Costello with Mr. W. Lord and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your licenses. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

In addition, our inspector examined those activities conducted under your License No. 06-01781-08 relating to the subjects covered in your letters to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I, dated January 31, 1979; to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Director of Material Safety and Safeguards dated July 19, 1979, and your letter to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Director of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards dated December 21, 1979. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.


