Ref: Amendment to component license for India

Dear Mr. Moore:

During our visit recently, you outlined the reasons for the delay in our attaining an amendment to the referenced license.

While we have strong differences of opinion regarding the position of the NRC and the State Department on this matter, we are obligated to follow governmental policy.

You did state, during our visit, that if the sale of fuel for the Tarapur reactor is approved, we would probably receive a favorable response to our license application/amendment.

We have learned that the fuel sale has been approved by President Carter, and we are pleased that we can now obtain our approval.

Since our request for amendment was on a license which expires in June 1980 and the products covered have not yet been ordered, it would be pointless to continue pursuing an amendment. We are therefore submitting a new application for the order expected to be received shortly.

Obtaining the license would enhance our position for obtaining the order which would, in turn, represent a \$200,000 credit to the US balance of trade.

We are anxiously awaiting approval.
