2. Cease all manufacturing and receiving of thoria.

3. Conduct a Geiger Counter survey of all "thoria" areas in the plant to locate all traces of thoria.

4. Place, if possible, all traces found (in 3) under lock.

Two kiln crowns will have to be dismantled and removed.

5. Continue existing personnel audit programs.

Done

- 6. Contact recognized consultants to develop a detailed decommissioning program that will include the following: (and other items) through week of 5/8
 - a. Conduct radiological survey to identify contaminated materials and equipment.
 - b. Establish specific program and notify Region III NRC of program.

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- c. Package material and equipment for disposal in accordance with NRC Regulations.
- d. Clean designated areas and package cleaning materials for disposal.
- e. Conduct radiological survey to determine that program was successful.
- f. Arrange for transportation and disposal of packaged material.
- g. Report results of radiological survey to Region III and Washington NRC offices.

It is estimated this program will take six months to one year to complete; therefore, it is assumed that applying for a license is unnecessary.

The program will be expedited as judicially as possible, using extreme caution at all times.

If there are any questions or if more information is required, we will respond as directed.
