Dear Mr. Lundvall:

Our letter of March 10, 1980, sent NUREG-0654 to all power reactor licensees and applicants for a license to operate a nuclear power reactor. As stated in that letter, the document, entitled "Criteria for Preparation and Evaluation of Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Preparedness in Support of Nuclear Power Plants," will be used to evaluate recently submitted upgraded emergency plans.

The emergency preparedness review team has reviewed you upgraded plan dated December 31, 1979, against the evaluation criteria of NUREG-0654. The results of the review of the Upgraded Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant Site Emergency Plan were presented to your staff in the technical meeting held in Prince Federick, Maryland on February 20, 1980. Since this upgraded plan was developed prior to the issuance of NUREG-0654, many of the evaluation criteria were not addressed in your plan. Additional information relative to the evaluation criteria is required before the emergency preparedness review team can conclude that your emergency preparedness program is acceptable. Accordingly, your emergency plan should be reviewed against the evaluation criteria and a revision to the plan provided within sixty days from receipt of this letter.
