Gentlemen:

This is in reference to your letters of November 5, 1979 and February 14, 1980, in response to the Notices of Violation and Notices of Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalties sent to you with our letters of October 15, 1979 and January 10, 1980. The October 15, 1979 and January 10, 1980 letters concerned items of noncompliance found during our inspection conducted on August 2 and 3, 1979, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 29-13985-01 and 29-13985-04MD, at your facility in Bloomfield, New Jersey.

After careful consideration of your responses, we have concluded for the reasons given in the enclosed Order that with the exception of Item F.1, the items of noncompliance did occur as set out in the Notices of Violation, and that civil penalties should be imposed as proposed in the Notices of Proposed I position of Civil Penalties. After consideration of your response to Item F.1, we have deleted this item of noncompliance and no penalties are imposed for Item F.1. We will review your records of molybdenum breakthrough test results during our next inspection of your licensed program. Accordingly, we hereby serve the enclosed ORDER on Diagnostic Isotopes, Incorporated, imposing civil penalties in the cumulative amount of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000).

We plan to continue unannounced inspections of your licensed activities The results of these inspections, including your implementation of the corrective actions described in your letters, will be considered in determining whether any further enforcement action, such as modification, suspension or revocation of your license is appropriate.
