Dear Congressman woodling:

I am writing in response to your note of April 16, 1980, to NRC regarding the letter from your constituent, Mr. Elias Conley. Mr. Conley, who farms several miles from Three Mile Island, expressed his concern about a postible relationship between the deaths of several of his farm animals and his farm's location near Three Mile Island.

Mr. Conley's letter has been forwarded to NRC's Terrestrial Resources Section, which is currently studying possible health effects to farm animals in the vicinity of Three Mile Island that have been attributed to the accident. Members of the team will meet with Mr. Conley in the near future to obtain information about the problems mentioned in his letter. The team will also investigate possible links between cooling tower operation at Three Mile Island and animal pathology in the area. The investigating team plans to issue a report of its findings, which will be available to the nublic, later this year. They will send you a copy of the report when it is completed.

I trust that the team's contact with Mr. Conley will provide the first step in a satisfactory resolution of his concerns.
