This letter is in response to proposed regulation 10 CFR Part 19 Informal Conference.

I believe there is no such meeting that can be termed informal between the agency and a licensee. I don't see the need for this informal meeting since if there are substantive safety problems there are sufficient legal remedies where charges can be carefully reviewed. It appears to me that this regulation basically favors Unions to suit their own purpose which may have little to do with safety.

I would strongly disagree with the need for this regulation and would hope it be dropped as an example of over regulation.
