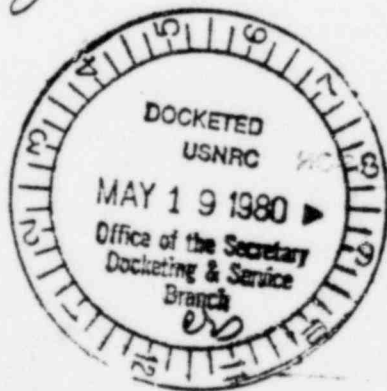

Your fish should be safe enough if you cook it well. *P. M. R. L.*

Because of the possibility of heavy metal and pesticide contamination, the State Health Department recommends that people make no more than one meal a week of fish caught in the San Francisco Bay. Also they recommend that pregnant women and small children not eat it at all. *M. R. L.*

No recommendations have been made for fish caught outside the Bay.
