The following information is provided in response to a telephone request from Larry Voorhees of Oak Ridge National Laboratory.

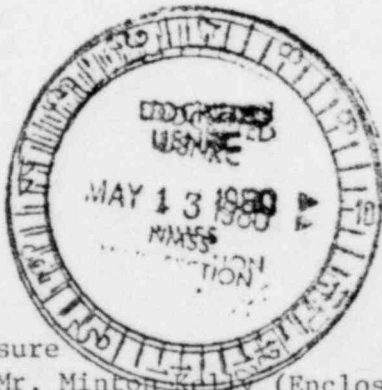
Enclosed is a map which shows the private land ownership of properties in the area of Edgemont, South Dakota, on which TVA has obtained options for the Edgemont Uranium mill decommissioning. Also shown are the properties owned by the State of South Dakota and Bureau of Land Management which TVA expects to obtain for the decommissioning.

It should be recognized that not all of this property will be disturbed as a result of decommissioning. At present, only that land area in the vicinity of the haul road, slurry pipeline, diversion ditch, and disposal site areas (refer to Figure 3.3-4 of TVA's environmental report) is expected to be disturbed. Other areas to be disturbed will depend on the need for borrow areas which will not be known until the completion of site specific studies.

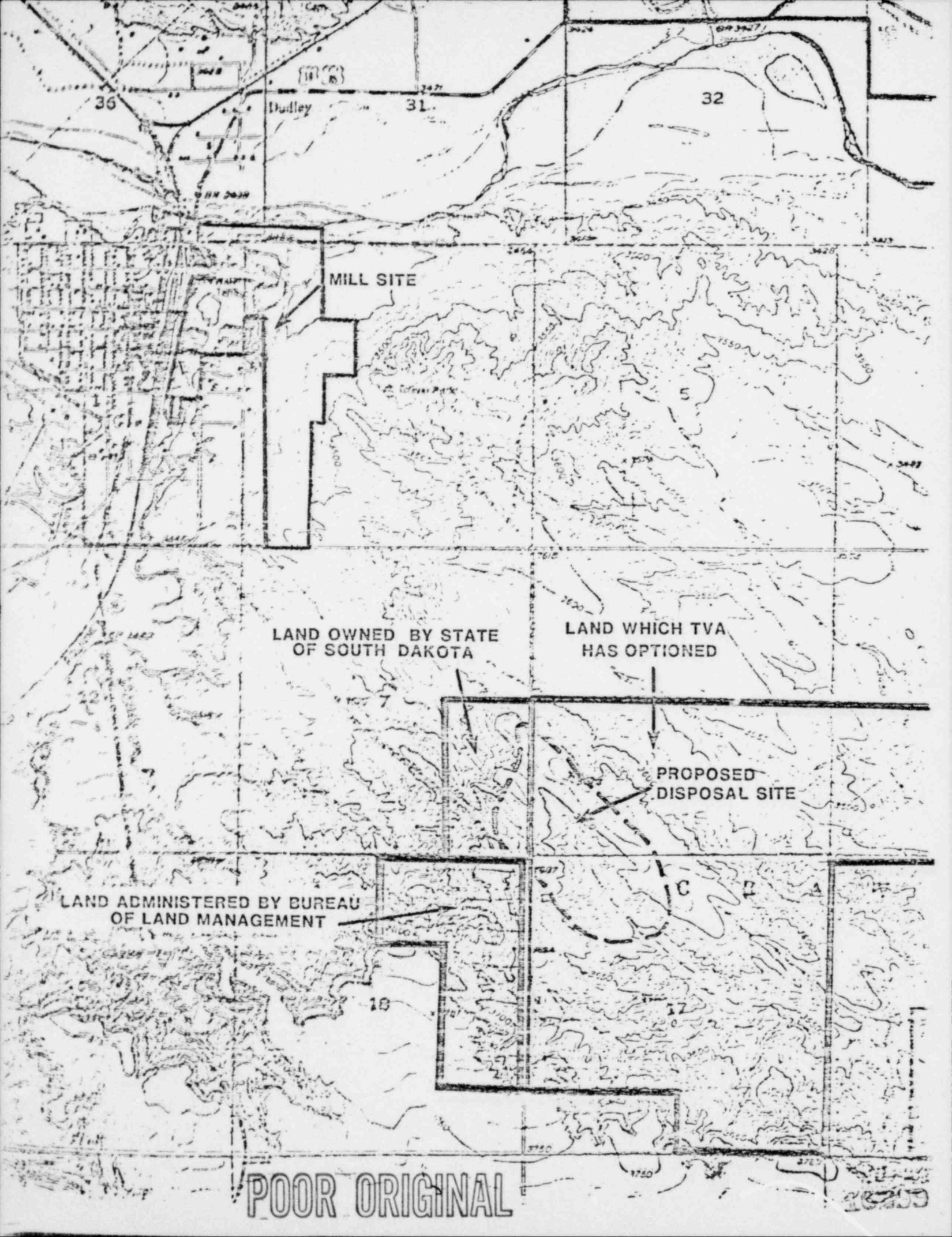
