SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NEW JERSEY PETITION ON BYPRODUCT
MATERIALS LICENSEES

We have reviewed the draft response to the State of New Jersey petition on requirements for major byproduct materials licensees, and have the following comment.

The statement in the draft that the Agreement States currently have no applications for major facilities is incorrect. This statement is made on page 2, paragraph 3, of the Commission paper; and on page 3, paragraph 3 of the Federal Register notice. Currently, there is an application in Texas and an application in Tennessee for major facilities; i.e., for facilities of processors and distributors whose license would be designated as inspection Priority I.

We have no other comments on the draft paper.
