Dear Mr. Trimble:

With the 7.7 million dollar facility that is presently being built and with the hiring of a librarian on those premises, I believe that the public would be better serviced by having the Nuclear Documents Collection, now housed at Arkansas Tech, transferred to this area. The collection is difficult, if not impossible, for us to service. I cite the lack of indexing and the lack of professional service to this collection. In addition, we have not had the personnel necessary to provide professional time to the indexing and general collection maintenance. Suitable shelving space is becoming limited in this library and we have been unable to satisfy the users of this collection in many instances.

If you will please send me an address or come by and transfer these materials we would appreciate it. We have done our best to service this collection and to furnish the manpower but seem to have met with little success due to financial causes and lack of staff.
