Topical Report




FIG. 17-2 QUALITY ASSURANCE ORGANIZATION

In accordance with Paragraph 4 of the referenced letter, notification is provided of a change in General Atomic Company's organization as depicted in Figure 17-2 of Amendment 5 of General Atomic's Quality Assurance Topical Report, GA A13010A, as amended on February 20, 1980.

The changes in Figure 17-2, titled Quality Assurance Organization, are in the names of the Fuel Operations Quality Control operations with functional and reporting responsibilities remaining essentially unchanged. The specific changes are Fuel Manufacturing Quality Control is renamed Fuels Quality Control, Quality Engineering is retitled Fuels Quality Engineering, and Quality Control Laboratory and Inspection is renamed Fuels Quality Inspection.

I have included a revised Figure 17-2 which replaces the copy transmitted on February 20, 1980 and will be incorporated in Amendment 6 of GA's Topical Report.
