Attached hereto is a copy of the contentions proffered by you on May 15 on behalf of your client. I have marked upon the copy the changes which you and I have tentatively agreed. As the Applicant has not seen our changes I am also sending them a copy of the contentions with the changes.

Yesterday I moved that the Licensing Board extend to Monday, June 16, 1980 the time for ZAC to file contentions and for the NRC Staff and Applicants to comment on these contentions.
