SUBJECT: REPROGRAMMING OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE RESOURCES

We have reviewed the reprogramming actions proposed by Mr. Case's memorandum of March 28, 1980 which are within Reactor Safety's scope of responsibility. We have no objections to the proposed reprogramming provided funds are made available to support the forthcoming RSB work on overcooling sensitivity for B&W reactors at Argonne. I understand that you have discussed the ANL work with T. Speis and that FY 80 funding in the amount of \$150,000 will be provided.

The five specific programs within our scope are as follows:

Failure Modes and Analysis	A6025	10

Two Phase Flow	A6525	29
Subcompartment Analysis	A7120	10

For Two Phase Flow, funds in the amount of \$88,000 and \$29,000 should be included in the FY 1981 and FY 1982 budgets respectively to allow completion of the work.

We have not addressed the proposed assignment of ongoing programs to the new organization since we understand that you have already developed that information. We know of no other needs for reprogramming action at this time.
