Dear Mr. Engelken:

As indicated in my letter of May 19, 1980 confirming my oral report on May 16, 1980 of discovery of a wall which was not adequately connected at its top to interfacing stuctural elements, and pursuant to Technical Specification 6.9.1.8.i, enclosed is Licensee Event Report 80-77 which describes the condition discovered. A more detailed description and analysis of the occurrence, cause of the occurrence and a description of and basis for the corrective action being taken are provided in the enclosed Reportable Occurrence.

We have determined that this condition was in nonconformance with Technical Specification 5.7.1 in that the wall did not comply with Final Safety Analysis Report requirements. The Plant is currently in Mode 6 with plans to enter Mode 5 approximately June 10, 1980. A schedule for completion of our investigations and modifications is provided in the report.
