Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Source Material and Byproduct Material License No. SUA-1378. This license authorizes Kerr-McGee to own, use, possess, and transfer source material and byproduct material that results from the minewater uranium extraction program at the Converse County Site in Wyoming.

The Environmental Impact Appraisal/Safety Analysis performed by the NRC staff in support of our licensing action is also enclosed.

Please note that license condition 20 requires Kerr-McGee to submit certain information on, and obtain NRC approval of, the solar evaporation pond design prior to construction of the pond. In addition, license condition 16 requires Kerr-McGee to submit and obtain NRC approval of a contingency plan, describing corrective actions to be taken by Kerr-McGee in case of any failures of the solar evaporation pond to provide waste containment, prior to discharging any wastes into the pond.

Also, note that the conditions contained in the license were discussed and agreed upon in conversations between Mr. W. J. Shelly of Kerr-McGee and Mr. G. Wu of my staff.
