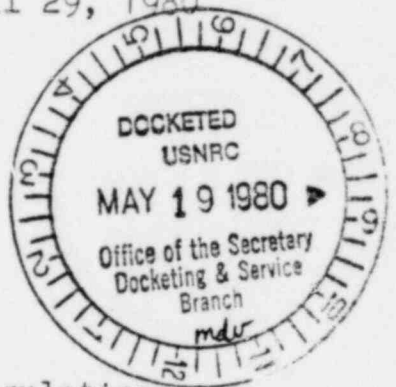

Dear Sir:

I have been reading "Environmental Protection Regulations for Domestic Licensing and Related Regulatory Functions and Related Conforming Amendments" (Federal Register Vol. 45, no. 43).

I find it appalling that a document like this one which purports to inform the public is couched in convoluted sentences and technical jargon making it impossible for the general reader to comprehend the contents.

This article contains frequent references to other documents of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, usually without footnotes explaining the nature of these other documents. Do you expect the public to have these documents committed to memory, or do you expect the readers to research the other documents while they are reading this one?

Actually, your intent is quite clear. You must make your documents public and so you do so. But you purposely obscure the content in a maze of complex sentences and technical vocabulary.

If you are really interested in informing the public, why not hire writers (not lawyers or engineers, but people from the general public) to write these documents or at least to paraphrase them for the public.
