This letter is to request a Minor, Safety and Environmental Amendment to Source Materials License No. SUA-1352. The Minor, Safety and Environmental Amendment is requested to change Source Materials License No. SUA-1352 License Conditions 10 and 11, pursuant to my two letters to you dated March 21, 1980, and May 7, 1980, and discussions held between representatives of The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company and Mr. J. E. Rothfleisch and Mr. G. Eddie of your staff during a meeting in Washington, D.C., on May 9, 1980.

It is requested that Condition 10 be rewritten to include two additional information transmittals dated March 21, 1980 and May 7, 1980. Condition 10 is requested to be rewritten as follows:

- 10. Authorized Use: For uranium recovery from uranium solution extraction studies in accordance with statements, representations and conditions contained in (1) the licensee's application dated November 3, 1978, and supportive information attachments; and (2) additional information transmittals dated January 16, 1979; March 21, 1980; and May 7, 1980.

It is requested that Condition 11 be rewritten to permit a project site area of forty-two and one-half (42½) acres. Condition 11 is requested to be rewritten as follows:

- 11. The uranium solution extraction activities shall be performed on a maximum well field area of less than one and one-quarter (1¼) acres within a project site area of forty-two and one-half (42½) acres according to the May 7, 1980 submittal.

A check for \$760 is enclosed for the Source Materials License, Minor, Safety and Environmental Amendment fee.

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During the meeting in Washington on May 9, 1980, Mr. Rothfleisch requested that the licensee submit a revised document containing the supportive information attachments of November 3, 1978, with revised dated pages inserted incorporating the additional information transmittals of January 16, 1979; March 21, 1980; and May 7, 1980. This document, when prepared, will contain the current licensed supportive information organized into one volume to assist license review, compliance and enforcement. The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company will be complying with this request as soon as practical.
