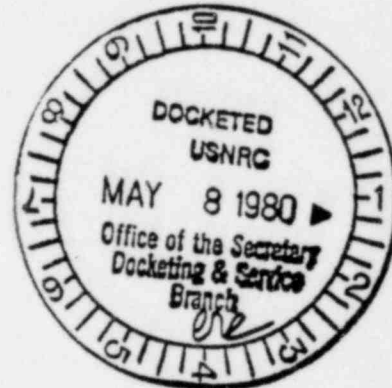

Dear Mr. Sinkin:

This will confirm, notify all other parties of our agreement to reschedule your deposition for the day before the Swayze deposition begins.

Your deposition will commence at 9:00 a.m. on June 18, 1980 in your office in San Antonio. As indicated, I would anticipate that your deposition can be completed in a day and if not, we can make some other arrangements.

I very much appreciate your rescheduling this deposition. The rescheduling was necessitated by the fact that the United States District Court for the District of Columbia scheduled a hearing in a case in which I have been actively involved in Washington for May 14.


