Dear Ms. McDonald:

This is in response to your letter of May 7, 1980, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of applications for licensure and actual licenses issued to Pharmaco-Nuclear.

Please find enclosed documents, as listed in Appendix A, which are subject to your request. Portions of documents, 20, 53, and 104 have been deleted in order to withhold home telephone numbers. Because disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, it is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (6) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(6).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The person responsible for this denial is the undersigned.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."

You agreed to pay the cost of reproduction of documents in your telephone conversation with Sarah N. Wigginton of this office on May 27, 1980.


