

Dear Mr. Macy:

FEMA is presently focusing its effort and resources on reviewing the adequacy of State and local emergency plans around operating nuclear power plants in accordance with the President's directive of December 7, 1979 and the NRC/FEMA memorandum of understanding. The nuclear power plants identified in Enclosure 1 are the sites for which a regulatory or licensing decision is expected in the next few months. As you know, NRC will not make decisions regarding full power operation without a FEMA review and finding regarding the adequacy of State and local emergency plans. To the extent that a FEMA review and finding can be provided consistent with the enclosed schedule, potential delays in licensing decisions can be avoided.

Your assistance in this effort is appreciated.
