It is our pleasure to announce the 12th Annual National Conference on Radiation Control, to be held at the Galt Hcuse in Louisville, Kentucky, May 18 through May 22, 1980. The meeting is jointly sponsered by the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, the Food and Drug Administration, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The Conference is an organization whose membership is comprised of the directors of 60 radiation control programs within the United States; the staff personnel of these programs may also join as associate members.
