

In accordance with the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974, as amended, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) hereby submits its quarterly report to Congress on the number of full-time permanent employees hired and promoted between October 1 and December 31, 1979. During that period, the NRC did not make any changes to the procedures followed in preparing job descriptions, informing potential applicants, and selections at grade GS-11 and above. Moreover, there were no significant actions to report on the steps taken during the quarter to promote the NRC EEO program.
