- 1. Thank you for your letters of February 4, 1980 and August 24, 1980, in response to our letters of December 31, 1979 and June 18, 1979, with an enclosure. As a result of our review of your letters, we have no further questions in regards to Deviation Notice Items A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, P, Q, R, S, T, V, X, and Y, and will review your corrective action and the implementation of steps to preclude recurrence during a subsequent inspection.
- 2. As a result of the meeting on March 7, 1980, with you and members of your staff, we are in agreement with your proposed verbal corrective action commitment. The following is our understanding of those commitments:
 - a. Deviation Notice 0 A furnace temperature profile will be determined in a manner that will clearly demonstrate component temperature variations across the furnace width.
 - b. Deviation Notice U The required Documentation of the repairs and subsequent, NDE operations associates with NCR 214 are available for review and Procedure G-107.0 will be revised to reflect the status of form ZQO.
 - c. To complete our records you must provide a completion date for these activities commensurate with your verbal commitment of approximately two (2) months.

In view of the above, we have no further questions at this time relative to Deviation Notice Items 0 and U and will review your corrective action and the implementation of steps to preclude recurrence during a later inspection.
