

the filing of a supplement unnecessary. If the Licensing Board
does not accept Petitioner's interpretation of §50.55 the relief
sought in the instant petition will be necessary.

As of the date of this comment the Licensing Board has not ruled on the matters to be considered in this licensing proceeding.
