Petitioner, People of the State of Illinois, reserves the right to supplement its Petition for Rulemaking, dated December 20, 1979 in the above-captioned proceeding. As Petitioner stated in its petition this proceeding is being requested in the alternative to a determination to be made by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board in the construction permit extension proceeding involving the Bailly Nuclear Power Plant (NRC Docket No. 50-367). If the Licensing Board adopts the interpretation of 10 C.F.R. §50.55 put forth by Petitioner that would moot this proceeding and make the filing of a supplement unnecessary. If the Licensing Board does not accept Petitioner's interpretation of §50.55 the relief sought in the instant petition will be necessary.

As of the date of this comment the Licensing Board has not ruled on the matters to be considered in this licensing proceeding.

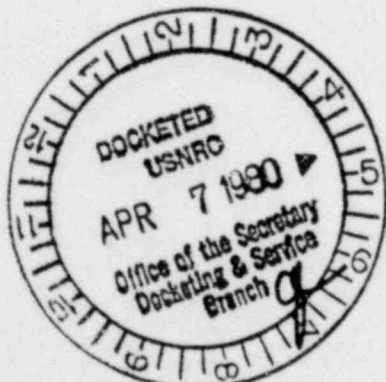
