EXCEPTION TO DECISION OF ATOMIC SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD

Intervenor, Chicago Section/American Nuclear Society hereby appeals the Order dated May 7, 1980 and, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §2.762(a), files the following exception to that portion of the May 3, 1979 decision of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board which was declared as final by the aforesaid Order.

Exception: The final ruling of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board dismissing the application for expansion of the Sheffield, Illinois low-level radioactive waste disposal site terminated disposal operations at that site and compelled transportation of waste to licensed disposal sites in other regions of the United States without consideration of the health, safety and environmental consequences of such action in violation of the Atomic Energy Act, 42 U.S.C. §2011 et seq. and the National Environmental Policy Act, 42 U.S.C. §4332(2)(C) and (E).

Designated Portion of Decision

The Licensee has moved to withdraw its application to expand the site by the addition of another 168 acres. The Staff and the intervenors, except Chicago Section of the American Nuclear Society, have also moved to dismiss this part of the application seeking to expand the site. Consequently, this Board hereby grants the motions to withdraw and dismiss this portion of the application pertaining to expansion of the site. (p. 4).
