Enclosed please find a letter from Westinghouse Electric Corporation requesting an amendment to export license XSNM-887 to increase the quantity of material authorized for export from 3,992 kilograms uranium-235 contained in 150,091 kilograms uranium to 4,182 kilograms uranium-235 contained in 158,012 kilograms uranium.

Before taking action on this amendment request, we would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the issuance of the requested amendment would be inimical to the interests of the United States, including the common defense and security, and whether the export would fall within an Agreement for Cooperation.
