This refers to your letter dated August 14, 1989, in response to our letter dated August 4, 1989.

Please note that the contamination limits specified in the regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation govern removable contamination on the exterior of packagings used to transport spent generators, rather than contamination of the generators themselves. This was discussed with you on October 6, 1989, during a telephone conversation between you and Ms. Joustra of this office. It is our understanding that you are currently wiping the exterior surface of packages used to transport generators and not the generator itself.

Thank you for informing us of the corrective and pr. tive actions documented in your letter. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.
