I have been in the Nuclear Power Industry for 20 years and have always supported greater involvement by the NRC into commercial nuclear power generation matters. However, after reading your proposal to require that credit checks be performed for personnel having access to nuclear power generation plants, I find that I am unable to support your current propsal.

I feel the current Fitness For Duty policy cheduled to go into effect in January, 1990, should be able to uncover the person who would be subject to blackmail or coercion. I also believe that the current MMPI exam would and should uncover any aberrant behavior, thus providing the same results.

In conclusion, I am **opposed** to your new proposal to require credit checks as I feel a program is already in place to give the same results without burdening the licensee's with more expense and without the preception that "Big Brother" is watching.
