Gentlemen:

This refers to a telephone contact conducted October 11 and 25, 1989. The contact was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance of the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The contact consisted of discussions with you and Mr. Ken Lambert of my staff.

As a result of this examination of activities, regulatory concerns were noted and are specified below. They may be evaluated at an onsite inspection at your facility in the near future.

As you described on the telephone, the following apparent regulatory concerns were identified:

- You failed to conduct physical inventories every six months pursuant to License Condition 16.
- You failed to amend your license when your organization's name was changed.

You should examine your license and NRC regulations to determine how you can correct the apparent regulatory concerns that you discussed on the telephone. Please submit to this office within 30 days of this letter, a description of actions taken or those that will be taken to correct the above mentioned regulatory concerns. In addition, we would like to highlight the following items that licensees should pay particular attention to as follows:

- Maintaining awareness and control of licensed material.
- Proper transfers and disposal of radioactive sources.
- Promptly reporting losses or thefts of licensed materials.
