This confirms the plans as discussed on November 6, 1989, between Mr. Tom Joyce of your staff and Mr. Wayne Shafer of this office for the NRC to conduct an Enforcement Conference on November 17, 1989, at 1:00 p.m. (CDT) at the NRC Regional Office in Glen Ellyn, Illinois.

The purpose of the Enforcement Conference is to discuss the apparent violation concerning the diesel generator room ventilation systems identified during the October 18 - November 6, 1989, inspection at Zion station. Specifically, the presentation by your staff should address the following:

1. Impact of elevated room temperatures on diesel generator reliability that includes life expectancy of components.
2. The methods and/or processes utilized to ensure the Zion operations staff has timely technical support for ascertaining operability of support systems.
3. The adequacy of the 10 CFR 50.59 review performed in November 1988 for changing the failure mode for the diesel generators' inlet ventilation fire dampers.
