Dear Sir or Madam:

On January 26, 1989, the U. S. Department of Labor's Wage and Hour Division in San Francisco received a complaint from Jerry L. Stinnett, an employee of Letterman Army Institute of Research. Mr. Stinnett alleged that he was terminated because he had raised safety concerns while performing his duties at Letterman. By a DOL letter dated August 11, 1989, the NRC learned that the complaint was settled and withdrawn pursuant to a settlement concluded on April 26, 1989.

The NRC is concerned that a violation of the employee protection provisions set forth in 10 CFR 30.7 may have occurred and that the actions taken against the former employee may have a chilling effect on other licensee or contractor personnel.

Therefore, you are requested to provide this office, within 30 days of the date of this letter, a response which:

- Provides the basis for the employment action regarding the former employee and includes a copy of any investigation reports you have regarding the circumstances of the action; and
- Describes the actions, if any, taken or planned to assure that this
  employment action does not have a chilling effect in discouraging
  other licensee or contractor employees from raising perceived safety
  concerns.

After reviewing your response, the NRC will determine whether enforcement action is necessary at this time to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.
