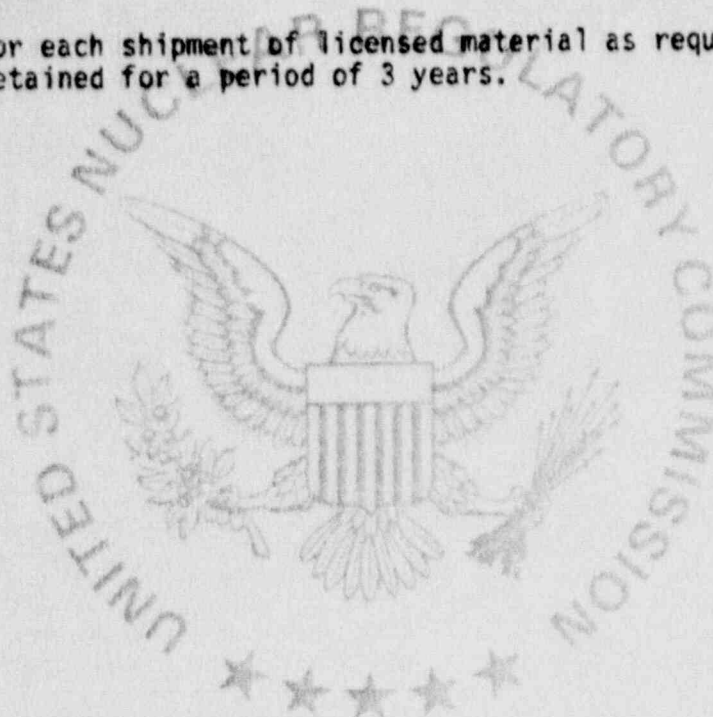


**QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM APPROVAL

All other activities (i.e., design, fabrication, assembly, testing, and modification) shall be satisfied by obtaining certifications from package suppliers that these activities were conducted in accordance with an NRC-approved QA program. It shall remain the responsibility of the licensee-user that all transportation activities meet the requirements of 10 CFR §71.101.
- Records for each shipment of licensed material as required by 10 CFR §71.91(a) must be retained for a period of 3 years.
